

ISP 164 Class Section Cancellation Policy

PURPOSE

States guidelines for class cancellation.

SUMMARY

The decision to cancel a class section will be made by department chairs/directors and their Deans and/or Associate Deans at least one week before the class is scheduled to begin, whenever feasible. Once the decision has been confirmed by the Dean to cancel a class section, enrolled students and instructors will be notified as soon as possible (see <u>ISP 164P</u> <u>Class Cancellation Procedure</u>).

STANDARD

The department chair/director, the Dean and/or Associate Dean will consider many factors when making the decision whether or not to cancel a class section. Cancellation of a section is normally considered when enrollment is low. Reasons for not cancelling a low enrollment class section may include, but are not limited to, the course only being offered once a year, the course being required for graduation, the course being the only option in a particular modality, or the course being part of a new program.
