WHAT'S HAZING?

Do you know the college hazing policy, or what to do if you experience hazing at Clackamas Community College (CCC)?

CCC defines hazing as,

“Hazing” includes, but is not limited to, any act that recklessly or intentionally endangers the mental health, physical health or safety of a student/staff for the purpose of initiation or as a condition or precondition of attaining membership in, or affiliation with, any College cocurricular or extracurricular activity, program or year in school.”

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!

Hazing is not allowed or tolerated at CCC. If you experience (or have) experienced hazing, please speak up. Complaints may be presented to any College administrator who will immediately notify the College official responsible for investigations.

You can also make “direct complaints related to educational programs and services to the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights. Direct complaints related to employment may be filed with the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries, Civil Rights Division, or U.S. Department of Labor, Equal Employment Opportunities Commission or other agencies as deemed appropriate”

In addition to making a report, CCC offers counseling services to students, and we encourage you to check in with them if you have experienced hazing. Counseling can be reached at counseling@clackamas.edu or by calling 503-594-3176.
