CLARIFICATION: Parent information is usually required on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for students who meet the criteria of a dependent student based on congressional definitions. In unique situations such as documented abandonment, parental drug abuse, parental mental incapacity, physical or emotional abuse, parental incarceration, or severe estrangement, the Financial Aid Office may determine a student to be independent for FAFSA purposes and thus not require parental information. Reluctance to request the income information from the parents or the unwillingness of the parents to pay for college or provide information for the FAFSA are not acceptable reasons to make a student independent.

- Submit at least two letters on letterhead from third parties who have personal knowledge of your situation and who can verify your circumstances. Examples of third parties include guidance counselors, physicians, social workers, clergy, or other individuals who have been involved in the circumstances in a professional capacity. All letters must be signed and need to include a telephone number and address where the individual can be reached for follow up questions.
