In addition to the departmental requirements listed above, students must also complete coursework for university admission, general education requirements and BA/BS requirements. Meet with a Southern Oregon University Academic & Career Coach to develop an effective transfer plan that will meet your individual needs.

General Education Requirements:

- **180** Minimum number of credits required to graduate from SOU
- **60** Minimum number of upper division (300 & 400 level) credits required to graduate from SOU.
- **45** Number of credits baccalaureate students must complete at SOU before a degree is awarded
- 24 Maximum number of "Professional/Technical" credits that can be transferred.
- "C" All credits must be completed in the Associate of Applied Science degree with a C or better. Some may be graded on a pass/no pass basis. A grade for "P" for these courses indicates a student earned a "C" or better grade.
