In addition to the departmental requirements listed above, students must also complete coursework for university admission, general education requirements and BA/BS requirements. Meet with a Southern Oregon University Academic & Career Coach to develop an effective transfer plan that will meet your individual needs.

General Education Requirements:

- **180** – Minimum number of credits required to graduate from SOU
- **60** – Minimum number of upper division (300 & 400 level) credits required to graduate from SOU.
- **90-94** – Number of credits needed to complete AAS Early Childhood Education degree at CCC
- **120** – Number of credits needed to take at CCC to complete all of the General Education requirements for SOU
